Your neighborhood will again be the backdrop of one of the most exciting events in area amateur and professional sports all year. For four days over Labor Day Weekend, Missouri's Top Professional Cycling Event, the **Bommarito Audi West County Gateway Cup**, will crown a champion on four different courses. Beginning in **Lafayette Square** on Friday night, then **Francis Park** on Saturday, the **Italian Hill** on Sunday, and in **Old Town Florissant** on Monday, the Gateway Cup is great (and free) entertainment for the whole family! We hope you will join us at the race- enter your kids in the Kid's Races, bike the Charity Rides, or just come have fun. Please note that during the race, the course will be closed to vehicular traffic.


Street Closures September 2nd from 6:00am until 6:00pm

- The entire race course route will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- All driveways exiting onto the course will be closed.
- There will be no automobile access or parking allowed on the course.
- Cars left on the course will be 'relocated' off course.

Important Information for Residents and Business Owners:

- The races will start at 9:00am and finish at approximately 6:00pm
- St. Francois from St. Pierre to N. Lafayette at 6:00 a.m.
- The full course including St. Francois, N. Lafayette, St. Joseph St., N. Jefferson St., Rue St. Louis St., St. Pierre St. will be closed to traffic from 7:00am to approximately 6:30 pm, as shown on the attached map.
- Emergency vehicles will not be affected by road closures.
- Residents who live on streets encircled by the route are encouraged to park outside the race course route.
- The City of Florissant Police Department stresses that residents remain patient when driving in the area of the event. Please drive cautiously and at safe speeds.
